Churton Park School Chromebook Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) agreement

(signed once when Chromebook is provisioned)

All year 4-6 students at Churton Park school are invited to bring a Chromebook to school to support teaching and learning. A signed agreement between the family and the school is required for students to be able to use a chromebook within the school programme, and the management console **must** be installed. Once this agreement is signed, you will be informed of the date an Aiscorp technician is available to install the management console and dashboard essential for your child to use this device at school.

I/We understand that:

- All devices brought to school are my child's responsibility and the insurance for the device is my responsibility.
- Teachers will provide a locked cupboard or room in which my child may place their device when not in use. If my child does not use this facility then the school holds no responsibility for any loss or damage which might occur.
- All devices must arrive at school each day fully charged and my child cannot bring a charger for use during the day
- Devices brought to school are for the use of my child. However, when working on a collaborative activity, other students may be using the device <u>with your child</u>.
- Students will use cloud based applications such as Google Applications for saving and/or sharing work.
- Rules, including the cyber safety policies, governing the use of any school-owned digital device will apply to student-owned devices, while they are at school, including adherence to the Copyright act.
- A Churton Park School Gmail account contract must be signed to use the chromebook and the mail account is the property of the school. This account is not to be used by families. Families are able to sign into Chromebooks using their own email accounts.

I give permission for Aiscorp to install the software required to connect it to Churton Park Schools' wireless network. Further, for Aiscorp to check and make changes to the device if any minor issues affecting teaching and learning arise.
