Learning Celebrations - Bookings Now Open

It is the time of the year when we celebrate the learning your child or children have done. Our Learning Celebrations are coming up and are on

Wednesday 3 September - 3.15pm - 7.30pm and

Thursday 4 September - 3.15pm - 7.30pm

This is an opportunity for whānau, teachers and ākonga to come together to celebrate the learning and achievements that have been happening. It is a chance for your child to share what they have done and what they are proud of.

You will have a 15 minute time slot which includes a 10 min conference with your child's home teacher followed by the opportunity to talk with other teachers in your child's learning space for 5 minutes. Each whānau can remain in the learning space with their child showing them around and there will also be some activities that your child is familiar with that you can join in doing with your

child if you choose.

Bookings can be made in the HERO app and are open now.

To book select School Bookings, then select manage bookings. This will show you your child or children's class as well as the available time slots. Simply select an available time and confirm your selection. Please note: HERO will not let you book back to back appointments if you have more than one child.



Out of Zone Enrolments 2026



The Board of Trustees invites applications from parents who wish to enrol "Out of Zone" students at Churton Park School. Churton Park School is governed by an enrolment scheme, details of which are available on the school website.

The Board of Trustees have approved 30 Out of Zone vacancies in 2026. Applications are made on the official enrolment form, which is available at the school office or online enrolment on the school website. The deadline for receipt of applications for out of zone places is Wednesday 8th October 2025 at 3pm. If a ballot for out of zone places is required, it will be held on Friday 10th October 2025. Parents will be informed of the outcome of the ballot within three working days of the ballot being held.

If you live in the home zone and have not yet signalled your intention to enrol your child, please contact the school immediately to assist us to plan appropriately.

Please contact the school office, phone 04 4784282 for details regarding the application process or email: office@churtonpark.school.nz The Board of Trustees have advised there will be 30 Out Of Zone places available to start 2026, across the school.

If you have a child already at school and have another child turning 5 in 2026, please make sure you have completed the online enrolment form so we are aware of your child.

Also, if you have neighbours with children turning 5 next year or wishing to change schools, please make them aware that we are now taking applications and have them complete an online enrolment form by Wednesday 8th October 2025 at 3pm.


Keeping Our Streets Safe and Accessible






