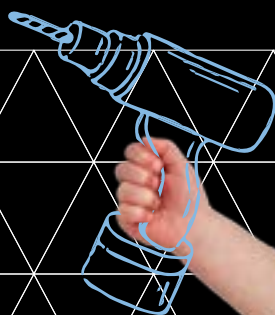
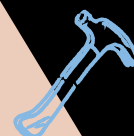
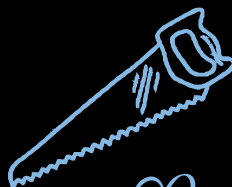

We had hoped that the new sunhats would be ready for the start of this term, but unfortunately

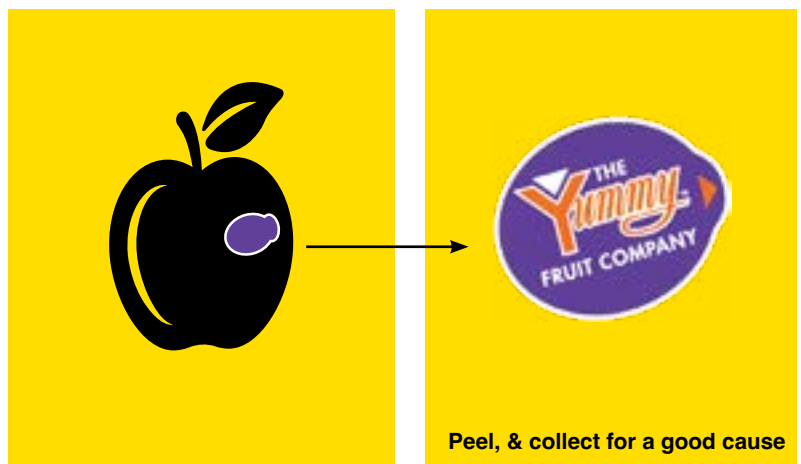
there has been a delay.
