Away for the Day' Cell Phone Policy

As you may be aware the Government has introduced regulations that require all state schools to put in place school rules regarding the use of phones. The regulations require that schools must ensure students do not use or access a phone while they are attending school, including during lunch time and breaks. This includes students who are on a school course or visit outside the school grounds.

"Away for the day", means cell phones and smart watches either do not come with the student to school, or are switched off and kept in bags when students enter the school grounds. The phone or watch must remain switched off for the whole school day.

Currently the school's Cellphone and Other Personal Digital Devices policy is consistent with this requirement. Please see our policy here: Cellphone and Other Digital Devices policy

International research indicates that phones in schools are not conducive for learning and for student wellbeing. Therefore, these regulations have been put in place to ensure that the learning of all students is maximised, while minimising any potential for distraction and cyber-bullying. In order for this to be effective and not to disrupt our learning programmes we ask parents/caregivers to speak to their child about these rules and reinforce the expectations of the school.


