

Like many schools in NZ, Churton Park School relies on donations as they make a significant difference to the delivery of our learning programmes. They enable us to provide resources that are not covered by our state funding. The Ministry of Education has removed the decile system and replaced it with a new funding system, as a result, we receive less government funding per child than some other schools.
