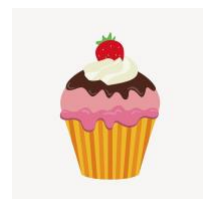

Touch Rugby Term 1 2024 - The Touch Rugby season is nearly upon us and we need to start sorting our teams. Mandarin Language Assistant

From mid-February we will again be hosting a Mandarin Language Assistant who will work 2 days a week in our school, two days a week at Amesbury and one day a week at St Benedicts School starting in mid-February. We are looking for a family who would be happy to host her for a term or two or even the whole year. They leave NZ in the beginning of December. The MLA's require breakfast, food available for a packed lunch and a cooked evening meal. They would require their own room, possibly with a desk and chair, wardrobe and drawer space and

the internet. The host family would be paid approximately \$300 per week. The host family are not required to transport them anywhere. In the holidays most MLA's team up and go travelling around NZ together. Mrs Goodall has hosted three previous MLA's so if this is something you could consider she is available to answer any questions. There is support available from the Confucius Institute and Victoria University who work together to bring these teachers to NZ.
