## Team Korimako blast off!



This term our Year 6 students have been taking part in the Wonder Project. This is an opportunity to work with Engineer ambassadors to learn about the science behind building and launching a water rocket. We were very lucky this year to be able to have not one but two engineers helping us! Hamish and Jock have been fantastic at supporting the learning of our students.

To build a rocket you need to understand about Newton's laws of motion. You need to understand about what forces are in play and how to modify your rocket after a failed launch. This has been just a fantastic learning experience. Watch out Rocket Lab!
